To qualify you must:

Be a COPFCU member in good standing (primary membership under your name and social security number).
Be at least a senior in high school or current student who will be enrolled full-time during August 2026 - June 2027 in one of the following:
Community college / university / graduate schoolTrade / vocational school
Submit proof of acceptance / enrollment in classes to be taken from August 2026 - June 2027.
Submit your latest course transcript detailing your name, cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher and school (whether high school, college or vocational/trade school).
Submit the attached application, responses to all questions/essays, and all items noted above by 5pm on February 13, 2026 .
